Registration: Online registration is open now at <https://www.bikereg.com/tidewater-winter-classic> and early discount will close at midnight on February 17, 2023. Race-day registration opens at 7:30 AM and closes 15 minutes before race start. There will be a \$10 fee applied after midnight for online and onsite registration. Collegiate riders pay \$30, Novice riders pay \$10. All other entries are \$45. Entry fee includes \$5.30 USAC and \$2.50 ACCC fees where applicable. No mail entries accepted. One-day licenses are available on BikeReg.com at time of registration. All Novice riders must have an annual or one-day license.

Location: Staging for all races is at York River State Park, 9801 York River Park Rd., Williamsburg, VA 23188. **Parking is \$5.**

Feed Zone: Feeding will be permitted as determined by the officials. The feed zone is located along Riverview Rd. near York River Park Rd. Feed zone parking is roadside on York River Park Rd. Do not park, litter or curse in the feed zone!

Rules: Refunds for medical reasons only. No refunds after February 16, no entry swapping or selling. Race runs rain or shine. All USAC rules apply. ANSI Z90.4 approved helmets must be worn at all times when riding on or near course. Center-line rule will be strictly enforced where applicable. Promoter reserves the right to combine or split fields based on the number of riders in any category. No aero bars permitted in mass start races.

Course: This is the traditional Tidewater Winter Classic road course, a 9.5 mile clockwise circuit, mostly flat with a climb near the KOA Campgrounds. Due to road conditions, the finish will be on Riverview Rd. prior to the turn onto York River Park Rd., instead of the traditional uphill sprint. Collegiate Riders: Collegiate points will only be awarded to full time collegiate students with valid USAC Collegiate licenses and full time high school students with valid USAC Junior licenses. Jerseys and bibs for all such riders must feature school names and/or logo, or be generic blank kits; non-scholastic club and trade team kits are not permitted.
